At SABS, classrooms, computer lab, seminar hall, audio-visual room, staff room and library are well equipped with ICT and Wi-Fi facilities. The faculty at SABS use various ICT enabled tools to enhance the teaching learning quality. There are 10 ICT enabled class rooms. Platforms like google classroom, E-mails, What's app group, Zoom App, google meet. Every subject teachers maintain google class room to assign and verify the Internal Assignments conducting online test, PPT presentations, address. Subject Syllabus, materials and question papers are uploaded in the google classroom and communicate the students to view and asked to upload the assignments in the same window. Teachers at SABS use ICT tools to teach and train the students through You-Tube, power point presentation, animated Video clippings, Audio system, online sources. By the blended learning, Students are exposed to use the e-resources for advanced knowledge and practical learning. In order to facilitate ICT, the institution has upgraded and increased the number of computer systems, internet connectivity with high bandwidth
