In a college with students of various streams like commerce business Administration and Science, students are carving out to get a distinct identity. This identity is achieved along with curricular and extracurricular activated.

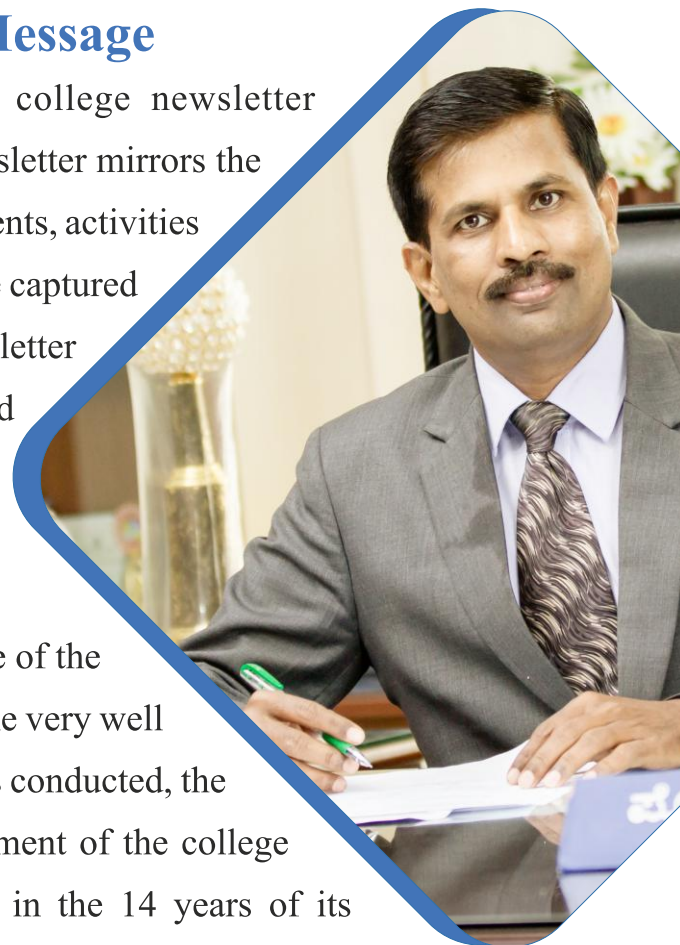

action for the year was framed and the needs of students from the forum was discussed. An orientation program was conducted for the first year B.Com and BBA students where a gist of the forum and its achievements were portrayed to the students.

The forum started its activities with Quiz competition being the most awaited competitions where around 100 students participated and forum also received good feedback from them. The forum then organised a 3 days GST workshop for the final year students carried by CA Suresh to give a good idea about GST being the hype of Commerce and Management in India. Later in the month of August, the students were taken to Indian Institute of Science Bengaluru for a workshop on Intellectual property rights which imbibed the students on how they can use their creative ideas to create a better system in the economy and what they can do to protect their ideas from fraud.

The forum also gave the golden opportunity to the final year students to enhance their grip on GST by offering an additional online course on GST in association with Artha Vidya Foundation. Placement & Value Added Programme

1. Resume Session—Mr. Prabhakar, Assistant Professor, SABs conducted both practical and theoretical session on Resumes to all the final year students. Students were asked to bring the resumes before the session was done, so that they can understand the gap between their preparation and the standard expected. After the session, students were advised to make the respective changes and take the same for further interviews.

2. Group Discussion – Ms. Navya and her team conducted GD sessions for all the final year students giving them live scenario of the GDs how they happen in the corporate interviews. The Do's and Don'ts were explained to students. The criteria which are measured or on which the candidates will be selected also were explained. Students were given topics on which they were supposed to discuss in group.

3. Android and Cloud Computing Technical Workshop – Ms. Jeevitha and Mr.Chethan, Technical Trainer. 30 hours (6days) Workshop on Android and on Cloud Computing each was conducted for Final year BCA students which gave them technical edge along with their regular curriculum.

4. Disciples India Pre-placement Test - Disciples India, our placement support for this year conducted Pre-placement tests to our final year students to analyze the gap between the student knowledge level and the industry expectations. A detailed report is being submitted by the Disciples team. Based on which 1 day On-Campus Drive was organized where 4 companies namely, Eureka Forbes, Trovech Infotech Pvt Ltd, Capgemini, HP on 26th April 2019.

5. Global MBA Orientation: SAGE - Seshadripuram Academy for Global Excellence was invited for an orientation program to our final year students who were interested in pursuing their higher education abroad. The team completely oriented the students on the procedure, program details, benefits, fee details, job opportunities, alumni details etc., Interested students should take up entrance tests like MAT/GMAT, IELTS etc., to get into this program. 1 semester will be studied in Yelahanka campus with all corporate trainers, remaining 3 semesters will be completed in any 1 of the 4 universities which the student opts to go for.

6. Goal Setting and Career Guidance - Team of Office – Ravi D Channanavar, officials addressed our students on how important is the Goal Setting for an individual life is essential. They gave few live examples from across the world which sets as an example and role model for the students. The only reason behind the great personalities success is the strong conviction towards their goals and commitment towards the achievement. 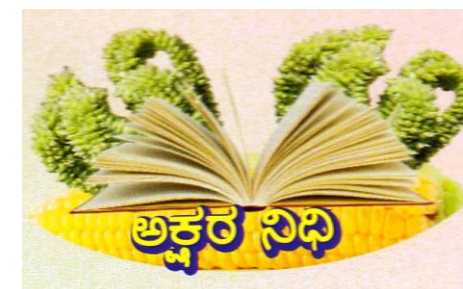
LEGAL AWARENESS PROGRAMME
