Various Approches to Value Education in Relevance of Swami Vivekananda

Value Education was founded with an aim to disseminate knowledge and maintaining highest learning standards of quality education through educational programs, broad research, and valuable teaching. It provides and focus on overall growth of the students by keeping them up with the latest market strategies and changes. Education practically to make its vision more clearly for those aspiring students who want to build a bright future.

All the courses provided are packed with information and are intensive in their approach. Providing education is a passion not profession. It should be designed dynamically as evolving course work to align with the rapid changes in global economy, society and business. With rapid changing in the business environment, cross-function, new functional, and business verticals have been rising which require to be completely veteran incorporating general management and strategic management skills.

The Goal or Objective of Education

Vivekananda points out that the defect of the present-day education is that it has no definite goal to pursue. A sculptor has a clear idea about what he wants to shape out of the marble block; similarly, a painter knows what he is going to paint. But a teacher, he says, has no clear idea about the goal of his teaching. Swamiji attempts to establish, through his words and deeds, that the end of all education is man making. He prepares the scheme of this man-making education in the light of his over-all philosophy of Vedanta. According to Vedanta, the essence of man lies in his soul, which he possesses in addition to his body and mind. In true with this philosophy, Swamiji defines education as 'the manifestation of the perfection already in man.' The aim of education is to manifest in our lives the perfection, which is the very nature of our inner self.

In his scheme of education, Swamiji lays great stress on physical health because a sound mind resides in a



sound body. He often quotes the Upanishadic dictum 'nayamatma balahinena labhyah'; i.e. the self cannot be realized by the physically weak. However, along with physical culture, he harps on the need of paying special attention to the culture of the mind. According to Swamiji, the mind of the students has to be controlled and trained through meditation, concentration and

practice of ethical purity. All success in any line of work, he emphasizes, is the result of the power of concentration. By way of illustration, he mentions that secrets.

Value Education has affiliations and approvals from Government institutions which are distinctive institutes of higher education. It provide a platform to explore and enhance the skill of students by maximizing opportunities for learning education and to stand strong in professional environment.

Swami Vivekananda (1863 – 1902), a great thinker and reformer of India, embraces education, which for him signifies 'man-making', as the very mission of his life. In this paper, which purports to expound and analyze Vivekananda's views on education, an endeavor has been made to focus on the basic theme of his philosophy, viz. the spiritual unity of the universe. Whether it concerns the goal or aim of education, or its method of approach or its component parts, all his thoughts, we shall observe, stem from this dormant theme of his philosophy which has its moorings in Vedanta.

Vivekananda realizes that mankind is passing through a crisis. The tremendous emphasis on the scientific and mechanical ways of life is fast reducing man to the status of a machine. Moral and religious values are being undermined. The fundamental principles of civilization are being ignored. Conflicts of ideals, manners and habits are pervading the atmosphere. Disregard for everything old is the fashion of the day. Vivekananda seeks the solutions

With this end in view, he feels the dire need of awakening man to his spiritual self wherein, he thinks, lies the very purpose of education.

The exposition and analysis of Vivekananda's scheme of education brings to light its constructive, practical and comprehensive character. He realizes that it is only through education that the uplift of masses is possible. To refer to his own words: Traveling through many cities of Europe and observing in them the comforts and education of even the poor people, there was brought to my mind the state of our own poor people and I used to shed

tears. When made the difference? "Education" was the answer I got.'

He states it emphatically that if society is to be reformed, education has to reach everyone-high and low, because individuals are the very constituents of society. The sense of dignity rises in man when he becomes conscious of his inner spirit, and that is the very purpose of education. He strives to harmonize the traditional values of India with the new values brought through the progress of science and technology.

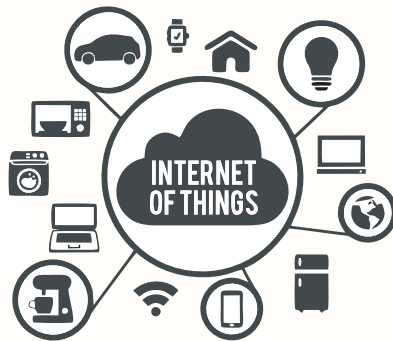


Internet of Things (IoT)

Have you ever imagined these possibilities?

When you're on your way home from work, you get an alert from your refrigerator reminding you to stop by the store !!!! or You can open the windows of your home remotely ,while you are at workplace....

Internet of Things makes it possible.



Internet of Things(IOT)can be defined as a vast network of devices connected to the Internet. Devices can be smart phones, tablets, vehicles, appliances, lighting, health and wellness devices, manufacturing systems, buildings, bridges, water pipes, food containers, electric meters, security systems, cameras, wearable devices, drones, and many moreand almost anything with a sensor on it.

The public Internet or private networks connecting these devices provide the communications between these devices—or "things."—These "things" collect and exchange data.

The concept of the Internet of Things first became popular in 1999, through the Auto-ID Center at MIT .Radio-frequency identification (RFID) was seen as a requirement for the IoT at that point. If all objects and people in daily life were equipped with identifiers, computers could manage and inventory them. Besides using RFID, the tagging of things may be achieved through barcodes, QR codes, bluetooth, and digital watermarking. There are two major subsystems involved in the IoT network .The front end part and back end part. Front end is mainly consists of IoT sensors. It includes optical sensors, light sensors, gesture and proximity sensors, touch and fingerprint sensors, pressure sensors and more. Back end consists of cellular, wireless and wired networks which are interfaced with IoT devices. The devices will report to the central servers and also interact with databases in the backbone network. Routers and gateways are part of the wireless backbone networks.

The IoT can be viewed as a massive network consisting of networks of devices and computers, it consist of :

- Tagging Things : Real-time item traceability and addressability by RFIDs.
- Feeling Things : Sensors act as primary devices to collect data from the environment.
- Shrinking Things : Miniaturization and Nanotechnology has motivated the ability of

smaller things to interact and connect within the “things” or “smart devices.”

- Thinking Things : Embedded intelligence in devices through sensors has formed the network connection to the Internet. It can make the “things” gathering the intelligent control.

Applications of IoT: The Ultimate Goal of IOT is to automate Human Life.

Demonetization

Demonetisation is a process of stripping of legal currency from it's state.

This action was taken by our prime minister Narendra Modiji on 8th November 2016 at 8:00pm. Which was announced live in all channels that all the Rs.500 and Rs.1000 notes of Gandhi series are being banned from 8 November 2016 midnight and who possess those notes would be exchanged with the new Gandhi series notes of Rs. 500 and Rs. 2000 till December 30th.

Modiji did not take this decision suddenly there was a background work for this decision. Modiji bought up "Digital India" at preliminary stage where he asked everyone to do their transaction through online. Later he acknowledged the black money owners to declare their amount of black money, where the government would cut off 45 percent as tax and pay back the remaining amount to them by converting it into white money. But unfortunately no one declared their amount black money. So it was the necessary step which he had to step in to this decision to trap those black cats.

We faced many consequences by the demonetization. On regard to this our society was the victim of both positive and negative effects.



This step has laid the successful foundation for our India to move it towards the development phase. It has been proved by some of the incidents those were:

Over the black money: This black money was considered as a cancer which affected the foundation of our economy. According to the survey done there was around approximately 36 thousand crores of black money in India and hence by this surgical strike the black money must be either deposited to bank or must be destroyed this were the two ways left with them.

Over fake currency: This project diluted it completely that is., according to ISI it has been said that there was about rs.400 crores of black money in the market and rs.70 lakhs of black money is being injected every year in our country. But by this step where the new notes hav technological benefit called "Modi ki note". It is impossible to make fake currencies.

Bank lending rates:Even the bank lending rates have been declined due to this effect because as the huge deposits flowed towards bank it reduces the cost of fund. Hence the lending rate has decreased by 125bps. Ex: housing loan lending rates earlier was about 13% but now it has been reduced to 3%.

Finance: By this demonetization the government has gained finance through the tax. It's because as the black money which are kept in individual houses remained unaccounted and non-taxable. But after this step the amounts were being deposited in banks where the government received 5.12 trillion amount as tax.

Hawala transaction: This transaction was considered as black shadow for our economy. But now it is completely unrest by this step. This was the transaction which helped in terror financing but now it has been eliminated from the society.

Over real state: It was considered that real state is the channel where the black money transacts more and more. Because of demonetization the black money held by the agents and this business was completely collapsed as there was no buyers and even no time to transact and convert their black money.

Over kashmir unrest: Before this action was put up into the existence we all noticed the kashmir terrorist attacks were being emerging like floods. The week before this step even there was a successful surgical strike by our India. After this implementation the four months turbulance was completely stopped as the terrorist didn't gain money for their attacks, arms and ammunition. Now the kashmir is completely rested in peace from the day of note ban. This illustration shows that this great step has washed the terrorism to the maximum extent.

Over Naxalities: Even naxalities are the worst victim of this strike because their complete oxygen was black money when this notes were banned they faced even problems to arrange the money for food as 86% of economical monetary fund was through rs.500 and rs.1000 notes in our economy.

It has even helped to lead the GDP rate by 0.5% to 1.5% as huge amount of money flowed towards the bank.

This were the some of the points which executes the positive effects of demonetization.

Yes where there is a advantage there is always a slot for disadvantage that is negative consequences same alike two faces of coin.

We read in many news papers and witnessed with our own eyes by television and ques in the banks.

Many people were not able to fetch the money needed for their activities, due to shortage of fund. But this shortage arised due to corrupted activities taken up by the bank managers but not by the supply of money. If the state government would had also given the best support the scarcity of funds would have been resolved as earlier as possible.

Many people lost their life by standing in large ques was the major issue which emerged in all the media. It was not at all the fault of the project it was because of the condition of affected person and his own health. Even we accept that the transportation halts that is about 8lakhs truck drivers and 4lakhs auto drivers faced problems, even our BSE or SENSEX got crashed and declined by 1689 points and NIFTY by 540 points. Our India based on farmers as the backbone even they faced problems to buy seeds, fertilizers and pesticides as they were not aware about or experts in online transactions. Even our small scale business were crashed by 30-40% and Industrial sectors output decreased by 47% all these may be have impacted badly on our economy. The loss which occurred by this crashed sectors are being recovered by those black money. When it comes to the ratio between black money and loss of demonetization the ratio of black money dominates. Hence it was very necessary to take up this firm decision.

For any good thing to happen or to touch the peak of the success it is necessary that and it is quite common we come across some hurdles. We have to gain the power which is immersed in every citizen and work and support this demonetization definitely our country will be the supreme among the world.

Instead of considering the black shadow of the issue lets celebrate the beautiful sun light which is leading us towards the way of developed country. This was not a action taken without plan, it was an action taken without giving time to black cats. All the politicians use to spoil the sleep of poor people but he is the first person to spoil the sleep of rich people. Lets lead us towards his action and withstand the cons for some days and enjoy the benefits later.

आज के युग में हिंदी पर बाजारवाद का प्रभाव

हिंदी केवल भाषा ही नहीं बल्कि वह राष्ट्र सम्मान भी है। भारत की जनसंख्या को देखते हुए विश्व के सभी व्यापारी समझ गए हैं कि हिंदी के माध्यम से ही इस बाजार में स्थान बनाया जा सकता है। इसलिए यह देखा जाता है की अधिकतर विज्ञापन हिंदी में होते हैं। विश्व के व्यापारी समझ चुके हैं कि व्यापार बढ़ाना है तो उन्ही की भाषा और लिपि के प्रयोग से अधिक लोगो तक पहुँचा जा सकता है।



बाजारवाद की एक और देन होगी अनुवाद के कार्य का विस्तार जैसे विश्व सिकुडता जायेगा वैसे- वैसे देश विदेश के विचार तकनीक साहित्य आदि का आदान-प्रदान अनुवाद के माध्यम से संभव हो सकता है। हिंदी माध्यम से अंग्रेजी फिल्म द मम्मी रिटर्न्स को सन २००१ में २३ करोड रूपए का लाभ हुआ जबकी २००२ में स्पायडरमैन को २६ करोड का और २००४ में स्पायडरमैन २ को २४ करोड का लाभ मिला। ये आंकडे एक उदाहरण है। जिससे अनुवाद उपयोगिता प्रमाणित होती है।

भारत एक बड़ा बाजार है, जहाँ के सभी लोग हिंदी में सम्प्रेषण कर सकते हैं इसलिए हिंदी का महत्व व्यापारी के लिए बढ़ जाता है। निश्चय ही भीडिया और फिल्मों में हिंदी के प्रचार – प्रसार में एक मुख्य भूमिका निभाई है। विरोध कर रहे कुछ क्षेत्रों में हिंदी फिल्मों की मांग बढ़ रही है। देश में ही नहीं, विदेश में भी टी.वी पर सबसे अधिक हिंदी चैनल ही प्रचलित एवं प्रसिद्ध है और यह इस भाषा की लोकप्रियता व व्यापकता का प्रमाण है।

पत्रकारिता के क्षेत्र में भी हिंदी का स्थान प्रथम है। भूमंडलीकरण व बाजारवाद ने नब्बे के दशक में हिंदी पत्रकारिता में क्रांति लाई। रंगीन एवं साज-सज्जा ने श्वेत – श्याम पत्रकारिता को अलविदा कहा। अब दैनिक पत्र नयनभिराम चित्रों के साथ प्रकाशित होते हैं। इसके साथ ही यह हर्ष विषय कि इन पत्रों के संस्करण कई स्थानों से एक साथ निकल रहे हैं। यह जानकार सुखद आश्चर्य भी होता है कि भारत में सबसे अधिक बिकनेवाला समाचार पत्र हिंदी ही है। जबकि अंग्रेजी में अधिक बिकनेवाला अंग्रेजी पत्र टाइम्स ऑफ इंडिया १० नं. पर है। दैनिक भास्कर समाचार पत्र की रोज ६ करोड ६० लाख प्रतियाँ छपती है जबकि सर्वाधिक बिकने वाले अंग्रेजी पत्र टाइम्स ऑफ इंडिया की ६५ लाख प्रतियाँ छपती है। इसी से हिंदी का प्रचार-प्रसार और फौलाव का पता चलता है। हिंदी का महत्व वैश्वीकरण एवं बाजारवाद के सन्दर्भ में इसलिए भी बढ़ेगा की भविष्य में भारत व्यावसायिक, व्यापारिक एवं वैज्ञानिक दृष्टि से एक विकसित देश होगा। भाषा वैज्ञानिको को इस दिशा में अधिक ध्यान देना होगा कि हिंदी की तकनीकी

शब्दावली विकसित करे और इसके लिए विज्ञान तथा भाषा में परस्पर संवाद बढ़े जिससे हिंदी तकनीकी तौर पर भी एक सम्पूर्ण एवं समृद्ध भाषा बने।

दो हजार पूर्व भारत ने उस समय विश्व के व्यापार क्षेत्र में अपना सिक्का जमाया था। जब वह अपने जायकेदार मसालो, खुशबुदार इत्रों एवं रंग-बिरंगे कपड़ों के लिए जाना जाता था। भारत का व्यापार इतना व्यापक था कि अपना माल पूरे विश्व में प्रसिद्ध हो और बेचा जा सके।

जब भारत विश्व का बड़ा बाजार हो जाएगा बाजार में व्यापार करने के लिए जिस भाषा का प्रयोग होगा उसे ही प्राथमिकता दी जायेगी और वही भाषा जीवित रहेगी। इस सन्दर्भ में यह भी भविष्यवाणी की जा रही है कि बाजारवाद के इस दौर में विश्व की दस भाषाएँ ही जीवित रहेगीं। जिनमें हिंदी भी एक होगी। भाषा को बोलनेवाले विश्व के कोने कोने में फैले हो जैसी ही हिंदी का भविष्य उज्ज्वल तो होगा ही।

विश्व स्तर पर ६ भाषाओं को सरकारी काम-काज को अंतराष्ट्रीय भाषाओं को दर्जा दिया है। यह भाषाएँ हैं – अंग्रेजी, फ्रेंच, स्पेनिश, चीनी, रूसी और दूसरी ओर हिंदी भाषा व्यापार के संपर्क भाषाओं के रूप में प्रयोग में आता है। कंप्यूटर युग में विश्व और सिकुड़ गया है। अब घर बैठे देश-विदेश की चीजें मंगवा और भेज भी सकते हैं और देश के किसी भी कोने से संपर्क किया जा सकता है। वाणिज्य सम्बन्ध स्थापित किये जा सकते हैं। ऐसे में संबंधित बोली जाने वाली भाषा को प्राथमिकता मिलेगी ही क्योंकि बाजार में जाना है तो वहीं की भाषा के माध्यम से ही अपनी पैठ बना सकते हैं।

ईस्ट इंडिया कंपनी के अंग्रेज भी आये तो हिंदी सीख कर ही आये थे, क्योंकि उनका व्यापार ठीक तरह जमाना चाहते थे। बाजार में भाषा का बहुत महत्व होता है अगर चीज का दाम बताया तो व्यापारी का व्यापार ठीक तरह से होगा।

आधुनिक युग में हिंदी भाषा का अपना महत्व है क्योंकि यह हमारी राष्ट्रीय भाषा है। आधुनिक युग में ज्यादातर व्यापारी अंग्रेजी और हिंदी दोनों भाषाओं को जोड़कर बातचीत करते हैं। आज के युग में अधिकतर बच्चे अंग्रेजी माध्यम से हैं, जिसमें पहले जमाने में हिंदी माध्यम से शिक्षा प्राप्त करते थे आज देश में बड़े बाजार जो खुले हैं उसमें ज्यादातर हिंदी भाषी थे, तो हाटमंडी, बड़े बाजार में हिंदी ही चलती है।

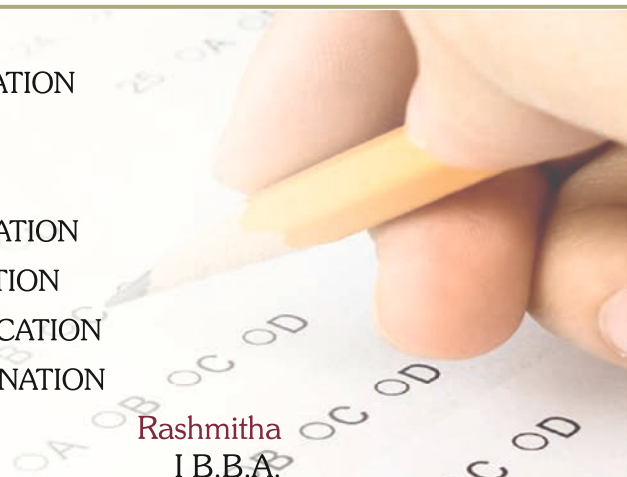

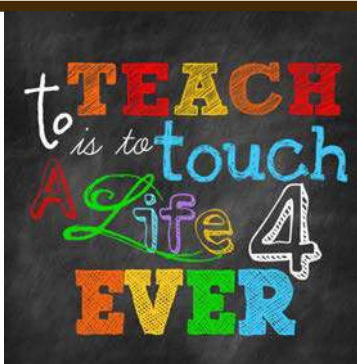

Child Abuse and Neglect

The impact of exposure to domestic violence on children and young people a review of the literature.

Objective

This article reviews the literature concerning the impact of exposure to domestic violence on the health and developments well-being of children and young people. Impact is explored across four separate yet inter-related domains (domestic violence exposure and child abuse; impact on parental capacity; impact on child and adolescent development; and exposure to additional adversities). with potential outcome and key messages concerning best practice responses to children needs highlighted.

Method

A comprehensive search of identified databases was conducted within an 11 year frame work (1995-2006). This yielded a vast literature which was selectively organized and analyzed according to the four domains identified above.

Results

This review finds that children and adolescents living with domestic violence are at increased risk of experiencing emotional, physical and sexual abuse of development emotional and behavioural problem and of increased exposure to the presence of other adversities in their lives. it also highlights a range of protective factors that can mitigate against this impact in particular a strong relationship with and attachment to a caring adult, usually the mother.



Conclusion

Children and young people may be significantly affected by living with domestic violence, and impact affect by living with domestic violence, and impact can endure even after measures have been taken to secure their safety.

Sir Adrian Cadbury Committee, which looked into corporate governance issues in U.K. defines Corporate governance “as the system by which the companies are directed & Controlled. The basic objective of corporate governance is to enhance & maximize shareholder Value & protect the interest of other stake holders”.

The Institute of Company secretaries of India has also defined the term corporate governance as under : “Corporate governance is the application of the best management practices compliance (OR) Jaw in true letter & spirit & adherence to ethical standards for effective management & distribution of wealth & discharge of social responsibility for sustainable development of all stakeholders”.

Thus in order to get a fair view on the subject we may summarize the Corporate Governance is a narrow & broad definition. In the narrow sense, Corporate governance involve a set of relationship amongst the Company’s management, its board of directors, its shareholders, its auditors & other stakeholders. This relationship, which involves. Various, rules & incentives, provide the structure through which the objectives of the company are set, & the means of attaining these objectives as well as monitoring performance are determined. Thus, the key aspects of good corporate governance include transparency of corporate structures & operations; the accountability of managers & the boards to shareholders; & corporate governance responsibility towards stakeholders. While corporate governance essentially lays down the framework for creating long – term trust between companies & the external providers of capital, it would be wrong to think that the importance of corporate governance lies solely in better access of finance.

In a broader sense, however, good corporate



governance – the extent to which companies are run in an open & honest manner – is important for overall market confidence, the efficiency of capital allocation, the growth & development of countries Industrial bases, & ultimately the nations’ overall wealth & welfare. It is important to note that in both the narrow as well as in the broad definitions, the concepts of disclosure & transparency occupy Centre – stage In the first instance, they create trust at the firm level among the suppliers of finance, In the second instance, they create overall confidence at the aggregate economy level. In both cases, they result in efficient allocation of capital Two definitions of Corporate Governance highlight the variation in the points of views : “Corporate governance is concerned with ways of bringing the interests of investors & manager into line & ensuring that firms are run for the benefit of investors... Corporate governance includes “the structures, processes, cultures& systems that engender the successful operation of organizations.

Good governance is integral to the very existence of a company. It inspires & strengthens investor’s confidence by ensuring company’s commitment to higher growth & profits; A properly structured board capable of taking independent & objective decisions is in place at the helm of affairs; The board is balanced as regards the representation of adequate number of non-executive & independent directors who will take care of the interests & well – being of all the stakeholders; The board adopts transparent procedures & practices & arrives at decision on the strength of adequate information; The board adopts transparent procedures & practices & arrives at decisions on the strength of adequate information;

The board has an effective machinery to sub serve the concerns of stakeholders; The board keeps the shareholders informed of relevant developments impacting the company; The board effectively & regularly monitors the functioning of the management tea; and The board effectively remains in effective control of the ffairs of the company at all times. The overall endeavour of the board should be take the organization forward, maximize long – term values & shareholders wealth.

The Kumar Mangalam Birla Committee constituted by SEBI has observed that “Strong Corporate governance is indispensable to resilient & vibrant capital markets & is an important instrument of investor protection. It the blood that fills the veins of transparent corporate disclosure & high quality accounting practices, It is the muscle that moves a viable & accessible financial reporting structure.”

N.R. Narayana Murthycommittee on corporate governance constituted by SEBI has observed “corporate Governance is the acceptance by management, of the inalienable rights of shareholders as the true owners of the corporation & of their own roles as trustees on behalf of the shareholders. It is about commitment to values, about ethical business conduct & about making a distinction between personal & corporate funds in the management of a company.”

THE FACTORS CONSIDERED

According to Jeremy Kelly, the Research Director of JLL, three factors help in measuring the India. Two of the factors depict the strength of short – term change whiles the other indicator the ability of the city to sustain that change. In addition to these three factors, other parameters like technology, research & development, population, real estate investment, connectivity, education, output and corporate activities have been taken l as the basis of formulation of the list.

Covering 134 major established and emerging “business cities,” the India, backs the speed of change of certain areal – such as the economy and the commercial real estate market – identifying which area has the political to maintain the greatest “dynamism”.

Cell Phones make you feel less connected to Friends and Family

The study suggested that the cell phone may have more social value for women compared to men and women may be better at using it to augment or complement existing social relationships.

Andrew Lepp, researcher at the Kent State University and his colleagues surveyed 493 students, ranging in age from 18-29, to see whether cell phone use, including texting and talking, was associated with feeling socially connected to their parents and peers.

The results show a significant difference between men and women. Female students reported spending an average of 365 minutes per day using their cell phones, sending and receiving an average of 265 texts per day, and making and receiving six calls per day.

Male students reported spending less time on their phone (287 minutes), sending and receiving fewer texts (190), and making and receiving the same amount of calls as the female students. For the women, the study found that talking on the phone was associated with feeling emotionally close with their parents. However, when it came to relationships with friends, texting was associated with feeling emotionally close.

For the men, the opposite holds true - daily calling and texting were not related in any way to feelings of emotional closeness with either parents or with peers.

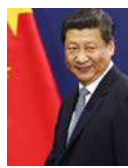

Awareness About Organ Donation

New Delhi: The number of organ donations is much lower in the country compared to other nations, experts said here on Wednesday.

"Indians need awareness on organ donation. Nearly 140,000 brain dead cases are reported due to road accidents, out of which 80,000 can be potential organ donors. But only a few organ donations are happening," Sunil Shroff, the chairman of Mohan Foundation, an NGO promoting organ donation, said

He was speaking at a function of Deceased Organ Donation Network and Transplant Education at Sir Ganga Ram Hospital.

"If 20 per cent of families whose member had a brain death donate his or her organs, all requirements for organ transplantation in this country would be fulfilled," D.S. Rana, chairman, board of management and department of nephrology at the hospital, said.

He said in Britain, the rate of deceased organ donation was 17 per million and in Spain, it was 35 per million. But in India, it was just 0.8 per million, he said.

According to Sir Ganga Ram Hospital, from 1995 to 2011, Tamil Nadu has performed 295 organ donations, Maharashtra 150, Andhra Pradesh 137, Delhi 64, Uttar Pradesh nine and and Chattisgarh seven.

"A person who suffers from brain death can save lives of about eight people as kidneys, lungs, heart, eyes, blood vessels, tissues, blood vessels, cartilage can be donated to needy patients. The deceased family should allow organ donation as their loved one can live even after death," Mamta Jain, who donated her son's organs after his brain death.

Waste Management

Food and Garden Waste (Green Service)

The Royal Borough of Greenwich collects food and garden waste from your green-top bin on corn starch sack (depending on your property type). The material is delivered to an in-vessel composting (IVC) facility in Dagenham, Essex, where it is turned into compact food waste refers to all cooked and uncooked food, including:

- ☞ Fruit and Vegetables
- ☞ Meat, fish and bone
- ☞ Plate scrapings
- ☞ Rice, Pasta and bread
- ☞ Tea bags and coffee grounds
- ☞ Used tissues or paper kitchen towels

Different types of waste we called

There are three main types of waste that you need to know about so you can put the right kind in the right bin for our collection teams: food and garden waste (green service) mixed dry recycling (blue service) non-recyclable waste (black service).

Wing your kitchen caddy

We provide residents with a six-litre kitchen caddy to store food waste in until there is enough to put into the bins or sacks for collection. Below are a few tips when using your caddy.

Usage Instructions: Same instructions for both white and green drum.

- ☞ Place one coco peat brick in a separate container (not the drum) and pour half liter of water on it in the evening. After 3 hours turn the brick upside down and add additional half liter of water. In the morning break the brick into powder. Now, it's ready to use.
- ☞ Place a piece of clean cardboard at the base of the green or white drum and make sure there is no staple pin or tape on it.
- ☞ Add 1 – inch thick layer of cocopeat powder in the bottom of the white/green drum.
- ☞ Add the daily kitchen waste (approx 750 gm) evenly on top of the cocopeat powder.
- ☞ Add enough cocopeat powder on top of the kitchen waste to cover it fully close the lid.
- ☞ Repeat steps 4 & 5 till the entire drum is full (approximately 9 weeks).

Waste Segregation

Waste had been a major environmental issue. Everywhere since the industrial revolution. Besides the waste we create at home, school, college and other public places, there are also those from hospitals, industries, farms and other sources. Humans rely so much on material things and they all end up as waste. And they where does the waste end up.

Everyone creates waste, although some people are every environmentally conscious and create very little. Likewise some countries do a very good job creating less waste and managing the rest. Others are pretty horrible and have created huge environmental problems for the people and animals living there.

All over the world, communities handle their waste or trash differently. Some common methods of managing their waste include land filling, recycling and composting. Other communities strongly embark on waste reduction and litter prevention (control aimed at reducing the production of waste in the first place. Some communities also engage in waste-to-energy plants and hazardous waste disposal programs.

Waste segregation refers to the separation of Wet waste and Dry waste and Reject waste, the purpose is to recycle dry waste easily and to use wet waste as compost.

Why should we segregate waste?

When we segregate waste, there is reduction of waste that gets landfilled and occupies space, air and water pollution rates are considerably lowered, segregating waste also makes it easier to apply different processes composting, recycling and incineration can be applied to different kinds of waste.

Here are some steps to Manage and Segregate waste:

- ☆ Keep separate containers for dry and wet waste in the kitchen.
- ☆ Keep two bags for dry waste collection paper and plastic, for the rest of the household waste.
- ☆ Keep plastic from the kitchen clean and dry and drop into the dry waste bin. Keep glass/plastic containers rinsed of food matter.
- ☆ Send wet waste out of your home daily. Store and send dry waste out of the home, once a week.
- ☆ Keep a paper bag for throwing the sanitary waste.

Practicing waste and segregation as a community.

The best way to practice waste management is to form a group of like minded people. The process of waste segregation should be thoroughly explained to family/neighbours in our apartment building. Create awareness amongst the staff in the apartment building/neighbourhood to help make the process easier. Acquiring separate storage drums for storing the dry waste and wet waste will be a great way to store bulk waste. Contact the local scrap dealer to collect the dry waste.

- ☆ Organic Waste: (Do not use a plastic liner) like kitchen waste, like vegetable/fruit peels, cooked food etc..
- ☆ Garden waste: Are fallen leaves/twigs, pooja flowers garlands weeds.
- ☆ Dry Waste : (Use only reusable bags for disposal). Plastic (must be rinsed of soiled) plastic covers/bottles/boxes items/chips/pizza boxes, etc... Glass should be (handle with care) unbroken glass bottles. Other dry waste: Rubber, old maps/dusters etc. E-waste (handle with care) Batteries, CDs/Tapes, Balbs/tub lights etc. (must be handover separately).
- ☆ Reject Waste: are does sanitary waste. (Use a newspaper for wrapping) diapers/sanitary napkins, bandages, condoms, swept dust. (limited quantities of mixed waste is allowed, such as heavily soiled plastic soiled paper)
- ☆ Garden waste from our campus grounds will be picked up separately.

Hand over your/ours fused tube-lights and bulbs separately. There is a separate bin for these items in the basement and there is a separate bin for the sharps items in the basement construction debris in large quantities will be charged extra per load.

So, those are the precaution of waste segregation.
